#### **Highlights from June 2023 Assembly**

<u>DELEGATE</u>: Katie gave her Report from World Service Conference, theme was Love, Laugh and Grow Together. <u>Questions from the floor</u>: How does Amazon sales of Al-Anon lit effect Amazon? Third party booksellers get a commission. But if the same literature is purchased directly from WSO, then Al-Anon does not have to pay these commissions. What's the status of Alateen electronic meetings? All Alateen online meetings are now overseen by the WSO. The goal is a cohesive approach to expand on-line Alateen meetings.

ALTERNATE DELEGATE: Liz reported that NJIS is not having regular meetings, so the Area is not in the loop with NJIS. The Area has Area Wide Insurance Policy and a Certificate is available on request if you need it for your meeting venue TREASURER'S REPORT: Mary reported the Checking balance and Saving balance. Profit and Loss reported. Quickbooks is moving to the Cloud, and Area will be moving its Quickbooks to the Cloud for now.
